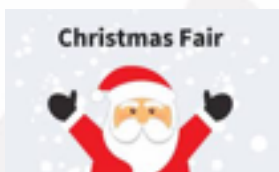
Please could parents also write their child's name on the packed lunch so that they are easily able to recognise their own.
