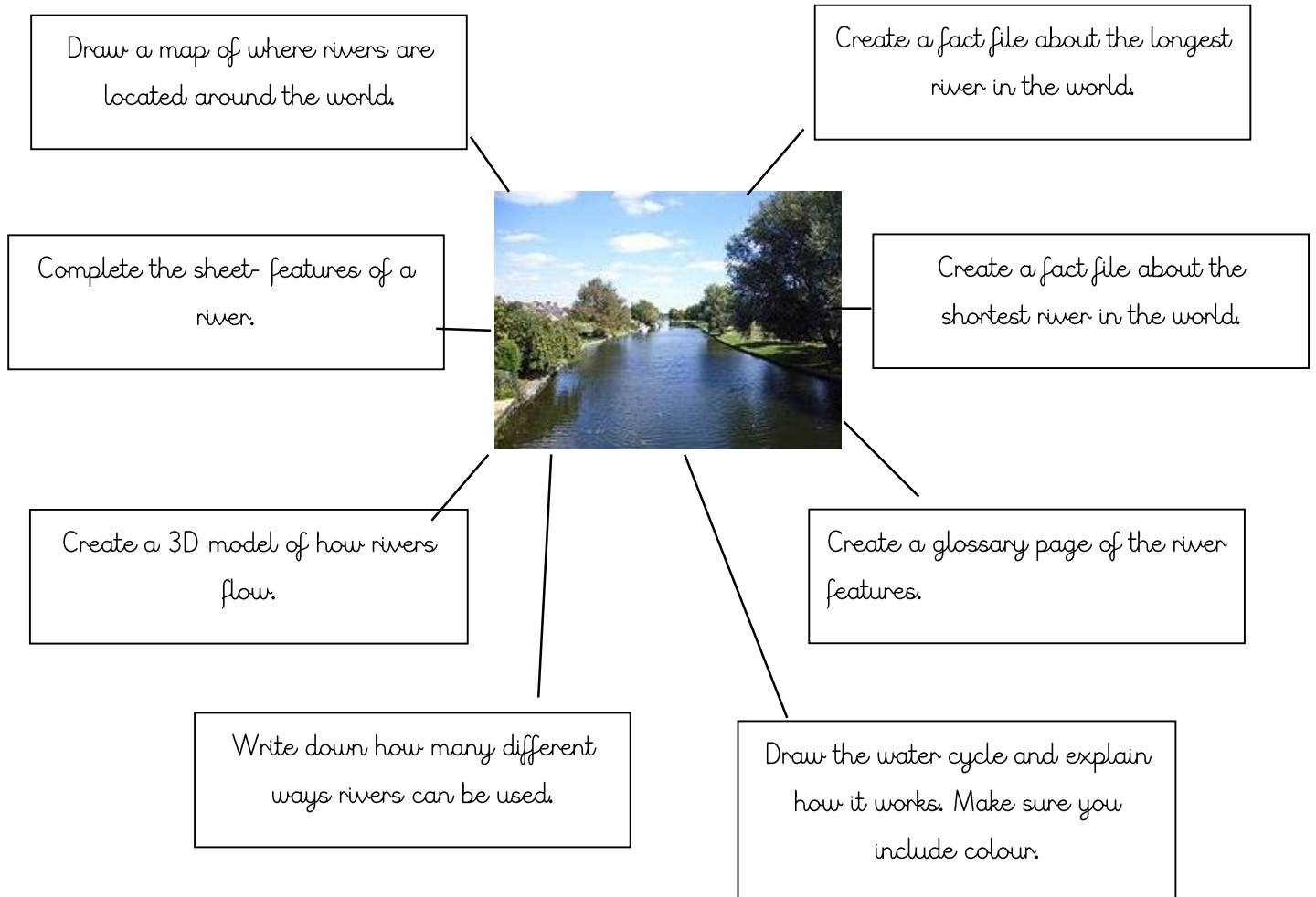


Year 6 Summer Brainbuilder activity one- Rivers
