Vocabulary Parade is coming and this year and we have a theme!

It is that time of year again when wish to celebrate our love of words and reading so we are asking children to take part in a vocabulary parade on Friday the 27th of June. (The last Friday of this half term)

In celebration of Her Majesty the Queen becoming the first British Monarch to celebrate a Platinum Jubilee after 70 years of service we would like the children to select a word based on this very special event.

Simply, each child will select a word that will become a costume.

- 1) PLAN Think of a word '...' that would have an interesting costume design. Unusual words and words that perhaps you may not understand the meaning of would be great.
- 2) CREATE You can recycle all sorts of items around your home to make a creative homemade costume: boxes, fabric, tin foil etc.
- 3) MAKE A VOCABULARY CARD/LABEL Remember to make a card or sign with your chosen word on it, so we'll know which word you represent.
- 4) COME PREPARED wear your costume to school on Friday the 27th of June. Each class will parade around the park and best efforts will be recognised.

Over the next few weeks, children can plan and make their costumes. A 'Costume design sheet' is attached to this newsletter to help your child plan his/her costume alongside a 'Jubilee word search' sheet. REMINDER - all children who have received their 100% attendance certificates in assembly will be allowed to wear their own clothes on Friday 13th May.


