#### **National Influenza Vaccination Programme 2022**

Dear Alexandra Park School Junior School (Yr 3 - 6),

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you and your school team for your continued support with the flu immunisation programme.

Over the past 3 years, the flu vaccination programme has seen several changes, including online consents, introduction of earlier non porcine gelatine intramuscular injection and our high school programme.

Along with your school's support, this has contributed to a successful programme across Greater Manchester. Together we vaccinated 62.1% of Primary school children and 40% of secondary school children.

Your overall vaccination rate was **53.3%** and the uptake for your school was **44.38%** compared to **37.61%** the previous year.

A successful delivery is highly dependent on systems/processes and organisation within the school. Thank you to Miss Thompson our School Flu Champion.

With your support we would like to encourage parents who have not responded, to fill in a yes or no consent form. Once consent forms have been distributed, we would appreciate your help in sending weekly communication/reminders to parents. We would like to offer our support with this with our teams coming to the school before or after to help parents complete forms or to attend parent's evenings and coffee mornings, where requested.

We look forward to working with you again in the Flu programme protecting the NHS, Communities, your school staff, and the children.
