- Look at a view from a high place including the use of digital software
 - Begin to use atlas maps and globes
 - Use index and contents pages in atlases
- Name and locate the four countries and the capital cities of the UK and the surrounding seas
- Identify a number of characteristics (rivers, mountains, climate, landmarks) of the UK
- Know which is the hottest and coldest season in the UK

Scientific Enquiry

- I can ask questions and use different types of scientific enquiries to answer them
