Dear Parents and Carers,

Road safety

As you will be aware we have been posting messages to parents/carers not to park outside the school gates and especially on the yellow zig zag lines outside of school. This is continuing to pose dangers to children as it is still taking place. We outline here developments towards keeping our children and families safe:

- 1) We wish to inform families that we have been placed on a rota and the road camera van will be issuing fines to anyone who is parked on these lines at anytime.
- 2) We have also applied to the council for the school to have pavement gates/ barriers installed directly outside the school entrance to prevent children from running out into the road.
- 3) This will however not be immediate so in the meantime we will be putting other measures in place after the half term break.

We thank you for your support and comments posted on Class Dojo and if we do not hear of movement on the pavement gates/barriers then we hope to ask families to support us in pushing this forwards.

School uniform -recycle and support

The hard work of the Eco Committee last year has resulted in APJS receiving the Eco Schools Green Flag Award. We did this by focusing on three project areas of sustainability: Litter; Energy and Water. Our work involved informing and encouraging everyone to be more mindful of their

behaviour with regard to waste and water/energy use.

This year, we would like to continue our work, with one of our focuses being

recycling. In view of this, we have placed a drawer unit in the foyer area of the school, where pre-loved items of school uniform can be placed - free to any parents/families that can make use of them.

We would also encourage that, if you have articles of school uniform that is no longer of any use to your children (they have left the school or outgrown it) and it is still in good condition, you donate to us so that it can be recycled. This way we can reduce the impact of the school/community on the planet further.
