Penalty notices

Since guidelines were issued by the Department for Education (DfE) in September 2013, Local Authorities have issued Penalty Notice fines to parents and carers who fail to ensure their children's school attendance meets the threshold. There have been concerns raised by many colleagues in Oldham schools about the increase in absences lost to holidays/leave taken in term time.

Having consulted with neighbouring authorities on the number of fines that they have been issuing per parent per academic year (and being mindful of the 'Working together to improve school attendance') it has been agreed that from 1st April 2024 Oldham will increase the number for holidays/leave taken in term time to 2 per academic year. This applies only for holidays and unauthorised leave, not for other unauthorised absences.
