




## History Curriculum Offer



- \*6 hours per unit of work.

## Stage 2 – Additional Support

- \*In class focus group with adult giving additional feedback on learning.
- \*Inprint resources used to support vocabulary.
- \*Word mats to help with key vocabulary.
- \*Sentence stems

## Stage 3 – Intervention

During the pre-assessment for history, children who have limited knowledge or gaps in learning are identified and targeted during lessons for additional support, such as;

- \*Small group work
- \*Peer support provided
- \*RRI's

Stage 4 – Further Support Learning broken down and only essential skills and knowledge taught to what is accessible.
