Stage 1 - Quality First Teaching. Every child receives at least:

*6 hours per unit of work.

*Disciplinary and substantive skills taught:

- Chronologically secure knowledge
- Understanding of world, local and British history.
- Connections, contrasts and trends across periods of time.

*Retrieval activities

Stage 2 – Additional Support

*In class focus group with adult giving additional feedback on learning.

*Inprint resources used to support vocabulary.

*Word mats to help with key vocabulary.

*Sentence stems

Stage 3 – Intervention

During the pre-assessment for history, children who have limited knowledge or gaps in learning are identified and targeted during lessons for additional support, such as;

*Small group work

*Peer support provided

*RRI's

Stage 4 – Further Support Learning broken down and only essential skills and knowledge taught to what is accessible.
