


- ❑ They form unique habitats where a range of animals and plants survive in a challenging environment.
- ❑ Coasts help us understand natural events, such as weather and changing sea levels.
- ❑ Coastal erosion is typically caused by various natural forces. These include ocean waves, wind, rainfall, as well as coastal storms.
- ❑ Crosby Beach is part of the Merseyside coastline north of Liverpool in the Metropolitan Borough of Sefton, England, stretching about 2.5 miles (4.0 km).
