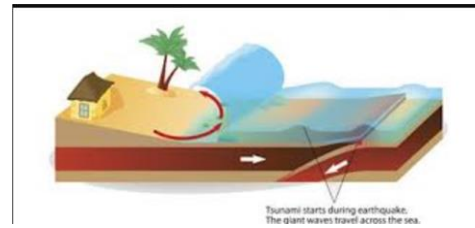

Vocabulary - Goldilocks words

Word	Definition
Fronted adverbial	are words or phrases placed at the beginning of a sentence which are used to describe the action that follows.
Parenthesis	the use of a phrase, word or sentence that's added into writing as extra information or an afterthought. It's punctuated by brackets, commas or dashes.
Modal verb	verbs that indicate likelihood, ability, permission or obligation. Words like: can/could, may/might.
Commas for singular possession	Possessive nouns are nouns that show ownership or a direct connection. Typically, singular possessive nouns use an apostrophe ( ' ) and the letter s at the end of the word to take the possessive form.
Emotive Language	Language used to create a particular emotion in the reader.
Commas to clarify meaning.	Adding a comma to a sentence can change the meaning of it entirely. For example: Let's eat Grandma - Implies that Grandma is going to be eaten. Let's eat, Grandma - Adding in the comma clarifies that it's time for Grandma to eat.
