



Spoken Language Curriculum Offer

Stage 1 - Quality First Teaching. Every child receives:

- Opportunities for all children to participate in group work and KAGAN talk.
- Word aware in all lessons.
- Choral speaking.
- Vocabulary parade.
- Active lessons to promote speaking and listening opportunities.
- Use of videos across the curriculum.

Stage 2 – Additional Support

- Focus groups with feedback being given by adults.
- KAGAN group work.
- Talking tins to facilitate oral rehearsal.
- Inprint resources to support vocabulary.
- Word mats for key vocabulary.

Stage 3 – Intervention

- During pupil progress reviews, children who are still struggling to progress are identified and appropriate targeted intervention is put into place, including:
- Pre-teach of key vocabulary.
- Discussions at the end of lesson to reflect on learning.

Stage 4 – Further Support

If summative assessment does not show sufficient progress being made despite intervention, liaise with SENDCO.
