## SCIENCE

Living things can be grouped (classified) in different ways according to their features.

Classification keys can be used to identify and name living things.

Living things live in a habitat which provides an environment to which they are suited.

These environments may change naturally e.g. through flooding, fire, earthquakes etc.

Humans also cause the environment to change. This can be in a good way i.e. positive human impact, such as setting up nature reserves or in a bad way i.e. negative human impact, such as littering.

These environments also change with the seasons; different living things can be



# **GEOGRAPHY**

Together, the four Fairtrade honey organisations in Argentina produce over 1,000 tons of honey each year - that's the weight of 150 elephants.

Fair Trade sugar cane is grown in 19 countries including Paraguay as well as Fiji, Malawi and Zambia

In 2018, the first Fairtrade School in India was announced with many more schools now working towards the award.

80% of the world's Vanilla comes from Madagascar.

Many Fair-trade tea farmers in Vietnam also grow Fairtrade spices like cinnamon

#### RE

Hinduism is a European word for describing a diverse religious tradition that developed in what is now northern India.

People within the tradition often call Hinduism 'sanatan Dharma' which means ' Eternal way' – describes a complete way of life.

Hindu ideas: four aims of life (Punusharthas)

- Dharma: religious or moral duty.

- 3) Kama: regulated enjoyment of the pleasures and beauty of life.
