



What have I previously learned?

- Demonstrate what may be similar and different in terms of physical and human geographical features in a contrasting non-European country (Kenya).
- Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to: beach, cliff, coast, weather, vegetation etc.
- Explain some of the advantages and disadvantages of living in a city or a village.
- Encourage children to ask simple geographical questions, such as: Where is it? What is it like?

Use simple comparison points

Vocabulary – Goldilocks words

Word	Definition
North West	One of the regions of England in the United Kingdom.
Region	A region is a specific area that has common features.
Urban	Areas referring to towns, cities and suburbs.
Rural	It refers to anything that relates to the countryside.
County	A place, typically one which has previously been uninhabited, where people establish a community.
East Anglia	An area in the East of England, often defined as including the counties of Norfolk, Suffolk and Cambridgeshire.

- I can describe its locality.
