### Vocabulary - Goldilocks words

<b>Beliefs</b>	the feeling of being certain that something exists or is true
<b>Qur'an</b>	The Qur'an (Arabic: القرآن) is the holy book of Islam
<b>Faith</b>	confidence or trust in a person or thing
<b>Judaism</b>	Judaism (the Jewish Religion) is defined as the totality of beliefs and practices of the Jewish people as given by G-d and recorded in the Torah (Hebrew Bible)
<b>Worship</b>	to honor or respect (someone or something) as a god
<b>Bible</b>	the sacred scriptures of Christians
