Word	Definition
Inspire	To fill someone with the urge or ability to do or feel something, especially something positive.
Savior	A person who saves someone or something from danger or difficulty.
Resilience	The capability to recover quickly from difficulties- a determination to keep going.
Suffering	The state of undergoing pain, distress or hardship.
Challenge	A task or situation that tests someone's abilities.
Contemporary	Belonging to or occurring in the present.
