







What have I previously learned?

- Explain some of the advantages and disadvantages of living in a city or a village



Sticky Knowledge

Vocabulary – Goldilocks words

 Canopy layer	The top part of the forest, where the tops of the trees touch. It's like a big, green roof made of leaves.
 Equator	An invisible line around the middle of the Earth. It's where the weather is hot and sunny most of the time.
 Climate	The usual weather in a place. Some places are hot, some are cold, some are rainy.
 Biome	A big area with the same plants, animals, and weather. A rainforest or a desert is a biome.
 Deforestation	When people cut down lots of trees. This can hurt animals and the Earth.
 Rainforest	A warm, wet forest with lots of rain, trees, and animals.
