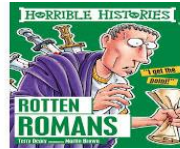

Every child will have had a letter sent home containing a code that will enable parents to sign up to the Class Dojo App, and another so the students themselves can sign in and add to their portfolios.

You can see your child's class story and what feedback they receive. Class Dojo is particularly important for children who are self isolating, as they will be able to access the continuing curriculum via this platform.

HOMEWORK
