## Non-uniform Day/Halloween


Thank you to all our families for their contributions towards our fundraising non-uniform/Halloween day. The total amount raised was £316.

A huge well done to all our children who have been in school everyday since the start of this academic year. The children were presented with a certificate today in assembly.






## Poppy Appeal
